- Debit/Credit card payments are accepted in person at the LEEP office with a nonrefundable convenience fee (4%).

- LEEP has been flexible but is working to get account balances paid in full.
- Please pay for the entire month of activities <u>AFTER</u> LEEP staff confirm your registration.
- Payment plans are available, but should be requested by calling 507-387-5122.
- Cancellations are appreciated as soon as possible. For night activities participants must call the LEEP office no less than 24 hours before the event to get a credit/refund. For special events on weekends they must call Thursday before 12 PM to get a credit/ refund.
