Enjoy a night out and unwind with your friends at LEEP! We will be watching a fun show while snacking on some hot delicious popcorn!



NO FOOD OR DRINK AT ACTIVITIES!

There should be NO FOOD OR DRINK brought into the VINE building during LEEP activities by participants or their staff. Participants are asked to arrange their schedules so that they eat and drink at other times. Any food or beverages that are brought will NOT be allowed in the activity space.



WINTER WEATHER REMINDER

Decisions regarding program cancellations will typically be decided by 2:00 p.m. on the date of scheduled event or 2 hours prior to practice for Special Olympics cancellations. <u>LEEP follows Mankato Area Public Schools' winter weather policy and will automatically close the office and cancel activities if school is cancelled due to weather.</u> When possible, LEEP staff/volunteers will call registered participants to notify them of a cancellation in advance. Cancellation notices may also be posted on LEEP's social media accounts.

Please call the LEEP cancellation line at 507-387-5122 (option 3) and listen to the recorded message to learn whether or not an activity/event/program will be held. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Voice messages left at this number will not be checked or returned.

LEEP requires that participants are properly prepared and dressed to participate in LEEP activities/events/programs. Participants should be dressed appropriately for the anticipated weather and have any other items they need to help keep them safe and healthy. In winter participants should be dressed in a winter jacket in addition to wearing winter boots, a scarf, mittens/gloves, a hat/earmuffs, etc. Layering of clothing is a good idea, especially during activities/events/programs that last for several hours or more.

$^{f 4}$ LEEP REGISTRATION CHECKLIST:

- You must be a 2023 LEEP member before registering.
- Decide what activities to register for.
- Call the LEEP office at 507-387-5122 to register (if no one answers, please leave only ONE voicemail). LEEP staff will respond as soon as they can.
- Drop off or mail payment for activities to LEEP at 929 N. 4th St. in downtown Mankato (zip code 56001).
- If needed, request a scholarship for up to 50% of the activity cost before the event. The scholarship form is available at www.mankatoleep.org.
- Debit/Credit card payments are accepted in person at the LEEP office with a non-refundable convenience fee (4%).

REMINDERS:

- LEEP has been flexible but is working to get account balances paid in full.
- Please pay for the entire month of activities
 AFTER LEEP staff confirm your registration.
- Payment plans are available but should be requested by calling 507-387-5122.
- Cancellations are appreciated as soon as possible. For night activities, participants must call the LEEP office no less than 24 hours before the event to get a credit/refund. For special events on weekends, they must call Thursday before 12 PM to get a credit/ refund.
- To check on LEEP cancellations, please call 507-387-5122 (press 3).
