



The City or Mankato and Community Partners are offering a free summer fishing program for youth ages 7-18 years old.

The program will be held from June 2023 to August 2023 at Lions Park in Mankato. The first date of the program will be June 14, 2022 and each Wednesday thereafter for the summer. The ending date will be on August 16, 2022. Each class will start at 9:00 AM and end at 12:00PM. Fishing poles and equipment are provided. Lunch will be served at 11:00 AM. If the youth has their own fishing equipment they can bring it.

The space for participants is limited to 25 people so early enrollment in the program is recommended. If the participant has a food allergy or any allergy please note it on the registration form.

The first day of the class will discuss the sport of fishing, fish species and laws, using a fishing pole and then fishing.

The continuing weeks will consist of fishing along with recreational safety topics and demonstrations by the Blue Earth County Dive Team, MN DNR, Mankato Firefighters.

Please fill out the Registration form, the Release of Information form, and return them to the address listed below. The forms can also be returned by email. The Release of Information form is a permission form so the youth can be used in a city photo and is not mandatory to be filled out.
