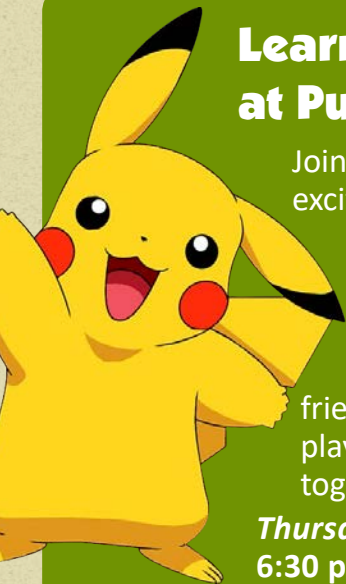


Learn to Play Pokémon at Pulp Comics

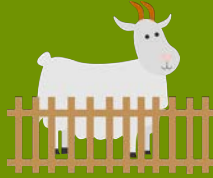
Ice Cream at Scoops

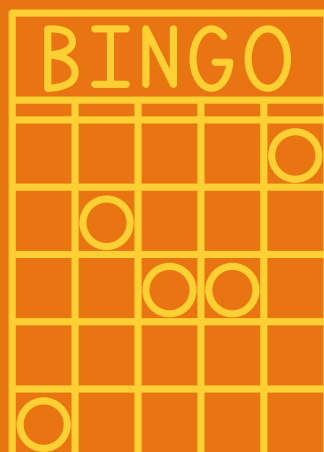

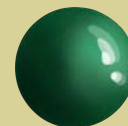

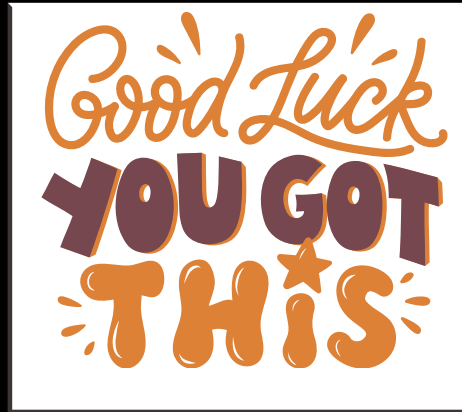
